INFORMATION REGARDING ACCESS TO SPANISH UNIVERSITY FOR STUDENTS FOLLOWING NON SPANISH OR MIXED EDUCATION SYSTEMS.

According to Education Law 2/2006 (3rd May) students from European Union Countries and other states with appropriate reciprocal agreements may enter Spanish universities without having to take the entrance (selectividad) examination, providing that these students have achieved university entrance requirements within their own educational system.

Accordingly ANY student from St. Anthony's may enter a Spanish university in one of two ways.

- As before, having followed the Spanish Education System, by taking the entrance examination – Selectividad.
- By “Direct Access”, whereby a grade is calculated on the basis of the final two years’ (Years 12 & 13) academic record. Admission to university from St. Anthony's College can be attained if students achieve grades above the minimum required by each university or faculty.

Access to university by either of these routes (methods) is called “General Phase”.

“Specific Phase”

Students applying for courses which require a higher grade – for example Architecture, Engineering or studies relating to Health, Medicine, Nursing, Physiotherapy etc. or courses for which there are more applicants than places, may take a voluntary supplementary examinations to achieve the required grades. This applies whether students opt for selectividad or direct access.
